

Role-Play Scripts

Narrator – Student 1 and Student 2 are playing handball at playtime. Student 1 hits the ball to Student 2 and Student 2 misses the ball.

Conflict Style 1 – Force (Crocodile)

Student 1 – ‘You’re out!’

Student 2 – ‘No I’m not. The ball landed on the line.’

Student 1 – ‘I’m not playing with you. This is unfair’.

Student 2 – ‘I’m not playing with you. You never play by the rules’.

Conflict Style 2 – Collaborate (Wise Old Owl)

Student 1 – ‘You’re out!’

Student 2 – ‘No I’m not. The ball landed on the line.’

Student 1 – ‘It was hard to see. Maybe we should re-play. Let’s ask the others to watch the lines closely’.

Student 2 – ‘OK, good idea’.

Conflict Style 3 – Avoidance (Turtle)

Student 1 – ‘You’re out!’

Student 2 – ‘No, the ball landed on the line’.

Student 1 – ‘You’re out Alex’.

Student 2 – ‘I don’t want to fight. I don’t want to play anymore’.

Conflict Style 4 – Compromise (kangaroo)

Student 1 – ‘You’re out!’

Student 2 – ‘No I’m not. The ball landed on the line.’

Student 1 – ‘Are you sure?’

Student 2 – ‘I promise, I saw it land on the line’.

Student 1 – ‘OK, let’s replay’.

Conflict Style 5 – Giving In (puppy dog)

Student 1 – ‘You’re out!’

Student 2 – ‘I thought the ball landed on the line’.

Student 1 – ‘No, you are out’.

Student 2 – ‘But....’

Student 1 – ‘No Alex, you are out’.

Student 2 – ‘OK’.
